- » Publication of research results in leading international journals
- » Participation in collaborative research activities, e.g. with EWI or the Faculty's Cluster of Excellence ECONtribute
- » Mentoring of doctoral candidates and projects
- » Supervision of bachelor and master theses
- » Teaching: four hours per week (i.e., two hours per week is one 90-minute course per semester)
- » Contributing to the administration of the Chair, in particular concerning the doctoral program
